The 3 BIG & Unavoidable Risks of Adoption

1. **The BIRTH PARENTS--it's not the child, it's where it comes from that's the risk.**

This is the single most important factor to consider when looking at ADOPTION. You can not ever be certain about the Parents who have birthed the Child you may adopt. The obvious circumstances of not knowing about what the parents were like, what they were doing, and what impact all of that may have had on your future Child, should be of major consideration. The typical “woman” who places her child for adoption is not actually a woman at all; it's a 16 year old, unemployed, uneducated welfare mom who can't afford to be pregnant and can't afford to care for a child. However, the things you will never know, such as emotional and psychological damage to the Child in the long term, in nearly every single case, and problems down the road will substantially impact You and Your family, for better or worse. Of course Adoption is honorable, the girls who place their children for adoption are doing so for the right reasons, and all Children deserve and need loving parents. At this point, though, You should be deciding on what You want in your Child, and understand the consequences of giving up control when you don't choose the origin of your Child.

2. **No CONNECTION, biological or not, when it comes to Adoption, You have No control over *anything*.**

Perhaps where all Couples begin in their decision to have a Child, is in the inspiration or realization whether or not it is possible to have a biological connection to your Child. Now, You know already the situation you are in and whether or not a Biological connection is possible for You, Your Partner, or both. And you certainly have your own feelings and desires about this. Either way, the obvious news is that Adoption gives you no connection.

And that's where the real miracle (and science) of Surrogacy is, versus Adoption. With Adoption, no one has connection, no matter what

information you are given no one is fully educated or aware of the what's behind the creation of the Child you may adopt.

By comparison, with Surrogacy you maintain full control over the entire process from conception to birth, and you will have all the information and background about either party. As you should know, there is significant testing and psychological assessments done for all People involved in the Surrogacy Process.

Surrogacy is, therefore, the closest to guaranteeing results as humanly possible, and allowing you to rest assured You know where the child you are longing for originated from.

The ultimate consideration when consulting with Couples is this - when realizing your dream and cherishing your new Child, do you really want to roll the dice and risk surprises? Or stick with a proven, verifiable program and process for creating your Child.

3. Hidden EXPENSE, while Adoption is *sometimes* cheaper in the beginning, it's the long term Financial Impact, through medical expenses, psychological problems, and the things you'll never know, until it's too late, that will get you.

I'm going to state this as simply as possible. This is the hidden reality and problem with Adoption that no one ever wants to talk about. While it is almost always cheaper **in the short run** to go through Adoption, the **long term** expenses that will come from raising a Child through Adoption can never be fully accounted for. It is no secret, that Adopted Children often experience things as they grow up that result in an ongoing financial commitment (birth mother issues, genetic defects, psychological impact, etc..)

This is the decision of risk and reward. Although no one bases the decision to have a child purely on the monetary investment, the reality is you can invest wisely from the beginning and chose a predicable outcome for you and your Child. The expression "you get what you pay for" truly applies in this most important decision...skimping on the quality of the origin of a child and going with a cheap adoption process, could very well have you paying for that decision for the rest of your life.

Control requires investment. Creation of your Child is an important decision, one that has implications and impact long after conception or choosing of a Child.

You can either choose the Woman to help carry and help create your child, and therefore have control over the outcome, or you can pursue adoption, where the woman the child came from remains a mystery (and that doesn't even begin to address that many women have no idea who the father is at all), and lose control over the outcome, financial implications, and most importantly, the health and well being of your precious child.
